

1. **Camille Giroud – Les Cras 2018 – Beaune:** Nice aromatic, flowery, delicious nose, which offers a nice maturity of the fruit as well as a certain intensity and complexity. It reveals notes of pulpy/juicy cherry, violet, and slight notes of ripe purple plum associated with touches of lily, rose, slight hints of ripe/pulpy currants as well as a hint of small blue fruits and fresh licorice. The palate is aerial, and fruity and offers juiciness, a tangy frame, a nice quality of fruit, tension, and gourmandize as well as purity (of the fruit). On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy cherry, pulpy/fresh violet plum, and slight notes of fresh bramble associated with touches of cornflowers, lily, and lilac as well as a subtle hint of laurel (on the finish). A discreet hint of noble varietal aromas. **Note: 16/20 – 92/100**
2. **Camille Giroud – Aux Clous 2018 – Savigny:** The nose is fruity, and gourmand and offers a nice sensation of texture. It reveals notes of morello cherry, bright purple plum, and slight notes of lily associated with some touches of bright small black fruits as well as discreet hints of star anise and a subtle hint of sweet spices. The mouth is fruity and offers freshness, minerality, a nice definition, elegance, precision, a certain straightness and a nice energy, a certain density as well as tension. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of pulpy/bright cherry, purple plum, and slight notes of fleshy/juicy blackberry, hints of small wild berries as well as discreet hints of flowers, good bitterness, and a subtle hint of laurel berries. Good sapidity and good length. Nice fresh fruits. **Note : 16/20 – 92/100**
3. **Camille Giroud – Aux Echanges 2018 – Chambolle Musigny, 1er Cru:** A nice nose that offers richness in elegance, and fleshiness as well as a nice maturity of the fruit. It reveals notes of morello cherry, crushed blue plum, and slight notes of blackberry cream associated with slight touches of cornflowers, terroir as well as slight hints of lily, vanilla, licorice and a very discreet hint of chocolate. The mouth is fruity and offers juiciness, freshness, a nice definition, minerality, a tangy structure, some fattiness, deepness as well as finesse in its richness (well-mastered). On the palate, this wine expresses notes of luscious/crushed cherry, cornflowers, and slight notes of fleshy blue plum associated with touches of blackberry cream, fine hints of crunchy wild small red fruits as well as a hint of lily, and mocha/spices. Beautiful racy and elegant tannins. Good bitterness on the finish/on the persistence. Good length. **Note : 16.25+/20 – 93/100**
4. **Camille Giroud – Les Avaux 2017 – Beaune, 1er Cru:** Nice aromatic nose and offers a well-mastered intensity as well as delicacy. The wine beneficiates from being decanted. It reveals notes of wild blackberry, ripe black fruit, and more slightly - notes of strawberry associated with slight hints of cornflowers as well as discreet hints of mocha, pepper, and a subtle almost varietal note. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, freshness, minerality, good definition, and accuracy as well as a nice juicy fruit. Currently, the wine is a bit restrained. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy cherry, juicy raspberry, and slight notes of juicy blackcurrant associated with touches of violet, a subtle varietal hint, pepper as well as a discreet/delicate hint of liquorice and a subtle touch of cardamom. A subtle hint of toasted/almost vanilla on the finish. Almost a discreet hint of over-ripeness on certain fruits. Good persistence. **Note: 16.5+/20 – 93-94/100**
5. **Camille Giroud 2017 – Pommard :** (Les Cras) Nice elegant nose, which offers complexity, freshness, a velvety touch as well as a certain power with delicacy. It reveals notes of luscious boysenberry, violet, and slight notes of ripe cherry associated with

touches of minerality, and lily as well as fine hints of blueberry and subtle hints of spices. The palate is fruity, and straight and offers juiciness, freshness, good definition, energy, a nice texture, as well as elegance. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy blackberry, juicy/fresh plum, and more slightly - notes of violet associated with touches of blueberry, cornflower as well as a subtle hint of rose and a very discreet hint of sens of the place/laurel/local grove. A beautiful clayey freshness. The tannins are a bit chewy. Good length. **Note: 17.5/20 – 95/100**

6. **Camille Giroud – Les Lurets 2017 – Volnay, 1er Cru:** The nose is fresh, fruity, and finely tight. The wine beneficiates from decantation. It reveals notes of raspberry, small pulpy red fruits, and slight notes of violet associated with fine touches of lilac, fresh violet, as well as discreet notes of fresh nutmeg. The palate is fruity, a bit aerial, it offers freshness, good definition, **some fatness**, minerality, a nice fresh frame, roundness, a nice texture, a nice volume, deepness, sapidity as well as fine straightness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of fresh/pulpy blackberry, fresh cherry, and more slightly notes of small red fruits associated with touches of fresh flowers, a subtle hint of fresh/pulpy blueberry as well as slight hints of star anise, of nutmeg and a very discreet almost varietal hint (in the finish). A lot of delicacy. The tannins are supple and elegant. Nice bitterness on the finish/persistence. **Note : 17/20 – 94/100**
7. **Camille Giroud 2014 – Charmes-Chambertin:** The nose is elegant, and flowery and offers aromatic power, a nice finesse of grain, velvety, a certain deepness as well as power in finesse. It reveals notes of fresh purple plum and more slightly - notes of fresh cherry, and violet associated with touches of wild red fruits as well as a slight hint of liquorice, lilac, and a subtle varietal hint. The mouth is fresh, mineral, juicy, and nicely acidulous and offers gourmandize, **some fatness**, and a nice finesse in its substance/unctuousity. It is a bit aerial in its power. Nicely racy and clayey. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy blue plum, fleshy/juicy blackberry, and slight notes of crushed raspberry associated with touches of small red fruit as well as hints of toast and toasted hazelnut. The tannins are fine and supple. **Note: 17.5/20 – 95/100**
8. **Philippe Pacalet 2020 – Gevrey-Chambertin:** The nose is fruity and offers crunch as well as a fine hint of fresh flowers. It reveals notes of pulpy/juicy blackberry, fleshy/juicy raspberry, and slight hints of violet associated with touches of fleshy strawberry as well as slight hints of lily and cherry blossom. The palate is fruity and offers freshness, a mineral frame, good definition, juiciness, freshness, minerality, tension, and certain straightness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of fresh/juicy raspberry and small fresh/crunchy red fruit associated with subtle hints of cherry, blackcurrant, and a subtle hint of cherry blossoms. Good length. **Note: 15.25/20 – 90/100**
9. **Philippe Pacalet 2020 – Nuits-Saint-George:** The nose is fruity and offers a fine power/intensity as well as a fine grain. It reveals notes of crushed raspberry and small ripe/crushed red fruit associated with discreet hints of blackberry, cardamom, and an imperceptible hint of lily. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, freshness, good definition, a certain straightness as well as some definition. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of pulpy/juicy raspberry, pulpy /juicy cherry, and more slightly notes of violet associated with touches of small red fruit as well as slight hints of almond and cardamom. **The tannins offer mellow texture and some chewiness.** Good length and good persistence. **Note: 15.25+/20 – 90-91/100**

10. **Philippe Pacalet 2020 – Pommard:** The nose is fruity, racy, and gourmand. It reveals notes of pulpy strawberry, crushed red fruits, and more slightly - notes of crushed blackberry associated with fine touches of nutmeg as well as a very discreet hint of chocolate. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, a mineral frame, a good tangy structure as well as a slight straightness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/fresh blackberry, tangy raspberry, and more slightly notes of small red fruits associated with slight hints of violet, and lily as well as a subtle varietal and savory/saline hint. The tannins are well-built. **Note : 14.75+/20 – 89/100**
  
11. **Philippe Pacalet 2020 – Aloxe Corton 1er Cru:** The nose is fruity and offers a fine richness of fruit as well as a certain intensity. It reveals notes of crushed strawberry, creamy blackberry, and more slightly hints of violet associated with a touch of chocolate as well as a subtle almost vanilla/toasted hazelnut hint. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a mineral frame, freshness, as well as **some stretchiness**. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of small red fruits, fresh cherry, and more slightly - notes of fresh flowers combined with a touch of fruits blackberry. **Note: 14.75+/20 – 89/100**
  
12. **Philippe Pacalet – Aux Argiles 2020 – Nuits-Saint-Georges 1er Cru:** The nose is fruity and offers juicy and crunchy fruit at the same time. It reveals notes of juicy/ripe cherry, small juicy/ripe red fruits, and more slightly - notes of cherry blossom associated with fine touches of fresh plum as well as discreet hints of nutmeg. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a fresh frame as well as limestone/racy minerality. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy blackberry, juicy/fresh raspberry, and more slightly - notes of juicy/fresh plum associated with slight touches of toasted almond, toast as well as a subtle almost vanilla hint. Good length. A subtle chewiness on the finish/persistence. **Note: 15.75/20 – 91-92/100**
  
13. **Philippe Pacalet – Les Sentiers 2020 – Chambolle-Musigny, 1er Cru:** The nose is fruity and offers a slight concentration, a slight tension as well as a very slight richness. It reveals notes of crushed cherry, crushed strawberry, and slight notes of juicy/pulpy plum associated with slight touches of chocolate and hints of crushed blackberry. The palate is fruity and offers freshness, minerality, good definition, and a slight density. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of raspberry, juicy cherry, and more slightly - notes of fresh plum associated with a touch of lily as well as discreet hints of racy minerality and a hint of toasted almond. The tannins offer a fine chew. Persistence is sapid. **Note: 15.5/20 – 90-91/100**
  
14. **Philippe Pacalet 2020 – Corton Bressande Grand Cru:** The nose is aromatic, and delicate and offers some complexity as well as good definition. It reveals notes of bright purple plum, cherry, and more slightly - hints of violet associated with slight touches of small crushed red fruits as well as slight hints almost of ripe almond. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, freshness, minerality, good definition, delicacy, a **captivating side** as well as a certain complexity. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of bright purple plum, bright cherry and more slightly - hints of violet combined with touches of cornflower as well as fine hints of crushed red fruits, a discreet hint of chocolate. A gourmandize. **Note : 16+/20 – 92-93/100**
  
15. **Philippe Pacalet 2020 – Echezeaux Grand Cru :** The nose is aromatic and offers elegance as well as a certain power in delicacy. It reveals notes of crushed raspberry, pulpy purple plum, and more slightly - notes of cornflower associated with fine touches

of cherry blossom as well as a discreet almost vanilla hint. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, freshness, good definition, density, and a certain fleshiness/richness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of fleshy/juicy cherry, fleshy/juicy violet plum, and more slightly - notes of violet associated with touches of fleshy blackberry as well as slight hints of toasted almond and a discreet hint of chocolate. The tannins are soft. Some chewiness on a good finish/persistence. A certain richness on the persistence which offers gourmandize. **Note: 16.25/20 – 92-93/100**

16. **Maison Chanzy – Les Cornières 2020 – Santenay:** The nose is fresh and offers a certain intensity as well as minerality. It reveals notes of racy minerality, fresh flowers, and more slightly - notes of crushed blackcurrant associated with slight touches of fleshy cherry as well as fine varietal hints. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a tangy/fresh frame, racy minerality, a nice energy on the tanginess, gourmandize as well as a certain density/richness of the fruit. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy cherry, crushed raspberry, and more slightly notes of blackcurrant associated with slight touches of cornflower, star anise, and toast. **Note: 15.25/20 – 90/100**
17. **Maison Chanzy – Les Bussières 2020 – Mercurey:** The nose is mineral. It reveals notes of ripe/fresh black fruits, crushed red fruits, and slight hints of lily associated with slight touches of boysenberry, rose as well as a discreet hint of spice. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, slight fatness as well as tension. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/fresh blackberry, juicy/bright blue fruits, and more slightly notes of raspberry associated with touches of rose/flowers as well as slight hints of toast and chocolate. The tannins offer some straightness. **Note: 15/20 – 89-90/100**
18. **Maison Chanzy – Le Bois Cassien 2020, Monopole – Mercurey:** The nose is racy and offers some power. It reveals notes of fresh leather, cherry, and more slightly - hints of fresh spices associated with slight touches of pulpy plum as well as slight hints of tea. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a mineral frame, freshness, tension, a **discreet tightness** as well as a slight intensity. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of morello cherry, quite juicy/fresh small red fruits, and more slightly - notes of violet associated with touches of fresh leather, spices as well as a hint of almond and clove. **Note: 14.5+/20 – 88/100**
19. **Maison Chanzy – Clos Voyens 2020, Mercurey Premier Cru:** The nose is toasted and offers a slight density, a velvety side as well as some gourmandize. It reveals notes of toasted bread, crushed boysenberry, nutmeg, and more slightly notes of crushed red fruits as well as a hint of pepper and liquorice. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, a tangy structure, good definition, freshness, and some **tightness**. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/ripe cherry and more slightly notes of small juicy purple plum associated with touches of small crushed red fruits as well as slight hints of violet, liquorice, toast, and an almost imperceptible hint of fig in the finish. Sapidity on the finish/persistence. **Note: 15+/20 – 89-90/100**
20. **Maison Chanzy – Clos du Roy 2020 – Mercurey Premier Cru:** The nose is fruity, and pulpy and offers a certain **mastered richness** as well as elegance. It reveals notes of fleshy/juicy cherry, fleshy/juicy raspberry and slight notes of pulpy wild blackberry associated with touches of violet as well as slight hints of Bourbon vanilla, lilac, nutmeg, and a discreet hint of toast. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a tangy structure, good definition, minerality, juiciness as well as a certain density in its fruit. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy cherry, juicy/bright blackberry, and slight notes of juicy/tangy plum associated with touches of raspberry, hints of lilac, violet, and

nutmeg as well as a discreet hint of chocolate, and a very discreet almost saline hint. The tannins are well-built, sapid, and supple. **Note: 15.75/20 – 91-92/100**

21. **Pierre Naigeon – Les Herbeux 2020 – Nuits-Saint-Georges** : (bio) The nose is aromatic and offers complexity, good definition, a nice fleshy/fresh fruit as well as some floral hints. It reveals notes of juicy/bright cherry, juicy/bright redcurrant, and more slightly - notes of juicy purple plum associated with touches of star anise, cornflower/lily as well as slight hints of fresh tobacco and a very discreet saline hint in the finish. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a nice freshness, minerality, a tangy frame, some fatness, energy as well as a good tannic structure. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/ripe cherry, small fresh/juicy wild red fruits, and more slightly - hints of lily associated with touches of violet plum as well as slight hints of violet, nutmeg, and salinity. A good job on the good bitterness. Nice juiciness and freshness. **Note : 15.5+/20 – 91/100**
22. **Pierre Naigeon – En Pallud 2020 – Gevrey-Chambertin**: The nose is fresh, racy, and offers some minerality as well as a certain racy power. It reveals notes of fresh wild blackberry, fresh wild red fruits, and more slightly - notes of clove associated with floral touches as well as a subtle hint of star anise and nutmeg. The palate is fruity and offers minerality, good definition, juiciness, fine density, a certain freshness as well as good work on the bitterness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/fresh raspberry, pulpy/fresh cherry, and slight notes of cornflower associated with touches of small fresh/juicy berries as well as slight hints of nutmeg and sweet spices. The tannins are fine and finely tight. **Note: 15.5/20 – 90-91/100**
23. **Grain de Nature par Pierre Naigeon – Les Corvées 2020 – Gevrey-Chambertin**: (bio) The nose is fruity, elegant, delicious, and offers some nice richness in balance as well as chewiness/pulpiness. It reveals notes of pulpy/fleshy cherry, fleshy/juicy blackberries, and more slightly - toasted notes associated with slight touches of crushed plum, flowers, and fruits as well as slight hints of cornflower, toasted hazelnut, and a very discreet hint of chocolate. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, gourmandize, a tangy structure, purity (of the fruit), a nice definition, a nice flesh, and some fatness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of pulpy/juicy raspberry, cherry, and slight hints of pulpy/juicy purple plum associated with touches of juicy blackberry, cornflower/lilac, and nutmeg as well as discreet hints of toast. The tannins are chewy. Presence of some chewiness on the finish/persistence. **Note: 16.5/20 – 93/100**
24. **Vincent Royet – Beauregard 2020 – Santenay 1er Cru**: Nice racy nose, mineral, precise, frank, which offers a nice finesse of the grain. It reveals notes of fresh cherry, fresh/crunchy berries, and slight notes of fresh iris associated with touches of racy minerality, a discreet hint of nutmeg, and an imperceptible almost vanilla hint that coats/underlines the fruit. The palate is fruity and offers a tangy frame, minerality, juiciness, and a nice finesse in its roundness as well as silkiness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy cherry, small fresh/crunchy red fruits, and more slightly notes of iris/varietal (and not vegetal) associated with touches of juicy/fresh blackcurrant, with fine hints of nutmeg, sense of the place as well as a discreet hint of fresh tobacco and liquorice. The tannins are supple and suave. **Note: 15.5/20 – 90-91/100**
25. **Domaine Guy & Yvan Dufouleur – Clos Genets 2020 – Santenay**: The nose is fresh, fruity, and offers precision as well as a nice power in delicacy and accuracy. It reveals notes of fresh cherry, wild blackberry, and more slightly notes of fresh berries associated

with a fine touch of blueberry, chocolate, and racy minerality as well as discreet hints of vanilla and an imperceptible hint of pepper. The palate is fruity and offers brightness, juiciness, a very nice definition of the fruit, purity as well as a bright/juicy fruit. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy blackberry, bright raspberry, and more slightly - hints of blueberry associated with touches of chocolate, toasted hazelnut, and a subtle hint of star anise. Good length. **Note : 16/20 – 92/100**

26. **Domaine Guy & Yvan Dufouleur – Aux Saint-Julien 2020 – Nuits-Saint-Georges:** Pretty fresh nose, aromatic, fine, elegant which offers crunch as well as harmony. It reveals notes of fresh violet, fresh lily, and more slightly - notes of racy minerality associated with touches of morello cherry, and fresh violet plum as well as slight hints of liquorice and chocolate/toast. The palate is fruity and offers freshness, minerality / a mineral frame, fatness, harmony, gourmandize, delicacy as well as a certain suavity. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of pulpy/tangy cherry, juicy/tangy raspberry, and more slightly - hints of bright berries associated with touches of racy minerality, lily/lilac, star anise as well as a subtle hint of fresh tobacco. The tannins are fresh, and elegant and offer a slight chewiness. Good length. **Note: 15.75/20 – 91-92/100**
27. **Domaine Guy & Yvan Dufouleur – Les Crots 2020 – Nuits-Saint-Georges, Premier Cru:** The wine beneficiates from being decanted. Nice elegant and racy nose, which offers a certain density/richness, some spiciness as well as a slight and discreetly tight grain. It reveals notes of violet, ripe purple plum, and slight notes of morello cherry associated with touches of toast, graphite, sweet spices, as well a subtle hint of clove. The mouth is nice, well-built, a bit aerial in its density/richness, nicely tangy and offers energy, a good guideline, a tangy frame, roundness, delicacy. All in finesse. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of violet plum, blueberry, and more slightly - notes of crunchy cherry combined with touches of currants as well as hints of nutmeg, toast, mocha, and a hint of clove. Nice freshness and minerality. **Note: 16.25+/20 – 93/100**
28. **Domaine Guy & Yvan Dufouleur – Les Vaumuriens 2020 – Pommard:** A nice racy nose that offers power, deepness, a certain complexity as well as a relatively tight grain. The wine beneficiates from being decanted. It reveals notes of fresh cherry, lily/fresh rose, and more slightly - notes of small fresh red fruits associated with touches of violet, and boysenberry as well as hints of racy minerality, graphite, and a subtle hint of gray pepper. The mouth is aerial, fruity, all in elegance, and offers suavity, minerality, a very nice acidity, precision, and finesse in its fullness as well as delicacy. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/tangy blackberry, small bright red fruits, and more slightly - hints of crunchy red fruits associated with touches of violet, fresh rose, hints of cardamom, incense as well as a subtle hint of mocha, crushed almond, and toasted hazelnut. Nice chewy finish and nice persistence. Congratulations! **Note: 16.5/20 – 93/100**
29. **Bouchard Père & Fils – Clos de la Mousse 2018, Monopole – Beaune, Premier Cru:** The nose is all in delicacy and offers racy power, accuracy, a certain intensity as well as deepness. The wine beneficiates from being decanted. It reveals notes of fresh purple plum, rose/lilac, and more slightly - notes of fresh/crunchy strawberry associated with touches of juicy cherry as well as hints of nutmeg, cardamom, vanilla pod, and discreet hints of fresh blond tobacco. The mouth is well-built, all in finesse/delicacy and offers accuracy, gourmandize, suavity, a nice sapidity, fullness, a nice balance as well as silkiness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy blackberry, juicy/pulpy cherry, and more slightly - hints of bright raspberry associated with touches of violet, purple plum, and lilac as well as slight hints of clove, cardamom, sweet spices, and

Bourbon vanilla. The tannins are supple and elegant. A very discreet hint of pepper in the finish. Nice gourmand and creamy persistence. **Note: 17+/20 – 94-95/100**

30. **Bouchard Père & Fils, Domaine – Taille Pieds 2018 – Volnay, Premier Cru:** Nice fresh delicate nose, which offers a fine incisive side, complexity as well as a velvety side. It reveals notes of morello cherry, purple plum, and more slightly - hints of blackberry associated with delicate touches of cardamom, and small blue fruits as well as slight hints of minerality/graphite and discreet hints of salinity. The palate is fruity, racy, and precisely chiseled and offers freshness, minerality, nice energy, a tangy frame as well as delicacy. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of pulpy/juicy blackberry, purple plum, and slight hints of bright/tangy cherry associated with touches of tonka bean, cardamom, racy minerality as well as a subtle hint of toast, and lily. The tannins are velvety and elegant. Nice iodized side and a good job on the bitterness on the finish. **Note: 17.5/20 – 95/100**
31. **Bouchard Père & Fils, Domaine 2018 – Le Corton, Grand Cru:** The nose is elegant, racy, and offers complexity, a multilayered side, as well as a certain power in finesse. It reveals notes of blackcurrant, violet, and more slightly - notes of ripe wild red fruits associated with slight touches of almost ripe cherry, Cuben pepper, lilac, and spices as well as a slight hint of blond tobacco. The mouth is all in subtlety and delicacy and offers a very nice silkiness, a lacy side, a slight richness, energy, a pretty guideline as well as a good balance. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of pulpy/bright blackberry, pulpy purple plum, and slight hints of violet associated with touches of fairly ripe/tangy red fruits as well as hints of toast, tonka bean, vanilla, with a subtle hint of flowers and chocolate. The tannins are elegant, delicate, and precise. A fine unctuousness at the end of the mouth. A gourmandize Nice and very discreet work on the good bitterness. Congratulations! **Note: 18+/20 – 96-97/100**
32. **Domaine Guy & Yvan Dufouleur – Renardes 2020 – Corton, Grand Cru:** A nice racy, complex nose that offers a certain power as well as a nice fine, powerful and racy grain. It reveals notes of violet plum, more slightly - notes of ripe berries associated with slight touches of cloves, and pepper as well as a discreet hint of crushed raspberry, toast, and spices. The palate is well-built, fruity and offers juiciness, a nice minerality/freshness, roundness in delicacy, energy, and a tangy frame as well as the purity of the fruit. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy redcurrant, bright cherry, and more slightly notes of juicy/bright blueberry associated with touches of plum, iris, racy minerality as well as a discreet almost iodized hint and vanilla. Good length. Fine hints of dark chocolate on the finish. The tannins are supple. **Score: 16+ /20 - 92-93 /100**
14. **Domaine Stéphane de Sousa – Les Vaumuriens 2019 – Pommard:** The nose is elegant, nicely floral, and offers subtlety, fruit as well as a racy and powerful grain. It reveals notes of wild blackberry, fairly ripe blackcurrant, and more slightly - notes of violet associated with touches of wild cherry as well as hints of Cuben pepper, nutmeg,

and a subtle hint of camphor/graphite. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, gourmandize as well as a tangy frame. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy blackberry, juicy blackcurrant, and more slightly - notes of juicy violet plum associated with touches of violet, small acidulous red fruit, slight hints of cornflower, nutmeg as well as discreet hints of graphite/camphor and sweet spices. Nice sapidity on the finish and good work on the good bitterness. Beautiful freshness and juiciness. **Score: 16.25+ /20 - 93 /100**

15. **Domaine du Château de Meursault – Clos de La Platière 2020 – Pommard:** Nice floral, racy nose that offers a certain power. It reveals notes of raspberry, rose, and more slightly - notes of juicy blackcurrant associated with touches of small red fruits, cornflower, camphor as well as a hint of tobacco and black pepper. The palate offers good definition, juiciness, a tangy frame, minerality, and silkiness as well as a nice work on the good bitterness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/tangy blackberry, small juicy/tangy red fruit and more slightly - notes of rose associated with touches of fresh cornflower, tangy plum as well as slight hints of tonka bean, toasted almond, graphite and a hint of toast/torrefaction. Good length. Nice sapidity and gormandise on the finish. **Score: 15.75 /20 - 91-92 /100**
16. **Domaine du Château de Meursault – Clos de La Platière 2019 – Pommard, Premier Cru:** The nose is spicy, racy and offers a certain complexity. The wine deserves to be decanted. It reveals notes of blackberry, blueberry and wild strawberry associated with touches of cloves, pepper, slight hints of spices as well as a discreet almost smoky hint and cocoa. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, a tangy frame, energy and good definition. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy blackberry, bright plum and more slightly - hints of cornflower associated with touches of bright redcurrant as well as slight hints of blueberry, clove, blond tobacco and a discreet hint of spices. The tannins are supple. Good length. **Score: 16/20 - 92/100**
17. **Domaine du Château de Meursault – Clos des Epenots 2019 – Pommard, Premier Cru:** Nice elegant nose, complete, complex, a bit floral and offers certain deepness. It reveals notes of blackcurrant, cornflower, and more slightly - mocha associated with touches of pulpy blue berries, bright cherry as well as slight hints of camphor, gray pepper, a very discreet hint almost smoky and with an imperceptible hint of vanilla. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a mineral structure, elegance, gourmandize, freshness, acidity and a fine crunch. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/pulpy blackberry, bright blackcurrant, and more slightly - hints of cornflower associated with touches of bright raspberry, hints of violet, pepper as well as slight hints of camphor, and cardamom, with a subtle hint of toasted almond and liquorice. A wine all in gourmandize, delicacy and which offers acidity/juiciness. Congratulation ! **Score: 17/20 - 94/100**
18. **Domaine Faiveley – Vieilles Vignes 2020 – Grevey-Chambertin:** The nose is elegant, and racy and offers a certain power. It reveals notes of boysenberry, violet, and more slightly - notes of bright wild berries associated with touches of smoke, pepper, bright

black plum as well as hints of spice, camphor and a subtle almost saline note. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, a tangy frame, a nice freshness, subtlety, a certain straightness (all in elegance), harmony, finesse, tension as well as a nice delicate touch on the palate. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of pulpy/creamy blackberry, juicy/tangy blackcurrant, and more slightly - notes of pulpy raspberry associated with touches of cornflower, violet, juicy/tangy cherry as well as slight hints of small tangy/bright blue fruits, vanilla, toast and nutmeg. The tannins are soft and elegant. Good length. **Score: 16.5 /20 - 93 /100**

19. **Philippe le Hardi – La Comme 2020 – Santenay 1er Cru:** The nose is spicy and offers some power as well as some intensity. It reveals notes of clove, pulpy/juicy blackcurrant, plum, and more slightly - spices associated with touches of fresh blond tobacco and a discreet hint of pepper. The palate is nicely fresh, mineral, and balanced and offers a mineral frame, juiciness and acidity. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of fresh/tangy blackcurrant, tangy plum, and slight hints of violet associated with touches of blueberry as well as hints of salinity, racy minerality, cloves, fresh leather, a subtle hint of fresh pepper and a very discreet hint of iris. The tannins are finely tight. **Score: 15 /20 - 89-90 /100**
20. **Domaine Roger Belland – Charmes 2021 – Santenay:** The nose is fruity and offers power, a certain gourmandize as well as a fine and relatively powerful grain. It reveals notes of fleshy cherry, ripe wild strawberry, and more slightly - notes of luscious blackcurrant associated with fine touches of violet, pear and a discreet hint of mocha. The palate is fruity and offers a nice juiciness, a nice freshness, minerality, a tangy frame, harmony as well as silkiness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of fleshy/juicy cherry, pulpy blackberry and more slightly - notes of creamy plum associated with touches of cornflower as well as a very discreet hint of coffee on the finish. Good length. A wine that is nicely fruity. Nice sapidity. **Score: 15.5+ /20 - 91 /100**
21. **Domaine Roger Belland – Beauregard 2020 – Santenay, Premier Cru:** The nose is aromatic, spicy, with a note of liquorice. It reveals notes of bright blueberry, bright blackcurrant, and more slightly - notes of small fleshy/juicy red fruits associated with touches of cornflower, liquorice as well as a very discreet hint almost fresh nutmeg and fresh vanilla. The mouth is fruity, bright, gourmand and offers purity in its fruit, roundness, nice volume, purity, generosity, a nice definition as well as a fine tension. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of bright blueberry, fleshy/juicy blue plum, and more slightly - hints of cornflower associated with touches of cherry, cherry blossoms, a subtle almost lilac hint, star anise as well as a very discreet hint of toast and fresh coffee (on the finish). The tannins are supple and sapid. **Score: 16.25 /20 - 92-93 /100**
22. **Domaine Roger Belland – Gravières 2020 – Santenay, Premier Cru:** The nose is fresh, racy, precise and offers tension, a nice gourmandise, finesse in its intensity as well as a nice racy, fine and powerful grain. It reveals notes of bright boysenberry, bright wild strawberry, and more slightly - hints of licorice associated with touches of crushed berries as well as hints of pepper, racy minerality, and a subtle hint of nutmeg. The palate



- is fresh, mineral, and balanced and offers gourmandize, harmony, delicacy, silkiness, fullness and a tangy frame. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of luscious blackcurrant, morello cherry, and more slightly - hints of violet combined with touches of star anise, mocha, racy minerality and a discreet hint of fresh blond tobacco. **Score: 16.5 /20 - 93 /100**
23. **Domaine Roger Belland – Commes 2021 – Santenay, Premier Cru:** Nice racy nose and offers intensity in finesse as well as a peppery notes. It reveals notes of fresh cherry, wild berries, and more slightly - pepper associated with touches of blackberry, lily as well as slight hints of small blue fruits and spices. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, nice acidity and a tangy frame. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/tangy blackberry, redcurrant, and more - slightly - notes of crunchy wild strawberries associated with touches of pear, iris, lily as well as slight hints of star anise and toasted/nutmeg. . The tannins are supple and fresh. Sapidity and a very discreet hint of chocolate on the finish. Good length. **Score: 15.75 /20 - 91-92 /100**
24. **Domaine Roger Belland – Morgeot-Clos Pitois 2020, Monopole – Chassagne-Montrachet, 1er Cru:** The nose is elegant, and racy and offers power in its delicacy, a certain concentration, accuracy, a certain intensity as well as slight notes of fresh spices. The mouth is well-built, racy, bright, a bit aerial, and offers nice freshness, a tangy frame, power in delicacy, accuracy, silky, nice fatness as well some spherical side. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of pulpy raspberry, roasted cherry, and more slightly - hints of cornflower associated with touches of pulpy plum, roasted berries, star anise as well as hints of chocolate, toast, caramelized almond. and a subtle hint of mocha (on the finish). The tannins are elegant, precise, supple and fine. **Score: 17.25 /20 - 94-95 /100**
25. **Louis Jadot – Clos des Ursules 2017, Monopole – Beaune, Premier Cru:** Pretty fresh nose, elegant, coating and offers delicacy and suppleness. It reveals notes of pulpy raspberry, violet/fresh rose, and more slightly - notes of pulpy/fresh cherry associated with touches of blackberry as well as a delicate hint of plum, spices and a very discreet hint of lily. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a tangy frame, minerality, good definition, delicacy, freshness, a certain gourmandize, suppleness as well as energy through its acidity. On the palate this wine expresses notes of juicy/fresh cherry, rose and slight lily associated with touches of pulpy purple plum as well as subtle hints of chocolate, sweet blond tobacco, with a very discreet hint of spices and an imperceptible almost peppery hint. A nice smoothness, elegance and a hint of acidity in the finish/persistence. **Score: 16+ /20 - 92-93 /100**
26. **Louis Jadot – Les Boudots 2017 – Nuits-Saint-Georges, Premier Cru:** The nose is fresh, precise and offers a certain tension, spices, a discreet hint of tonka bean as well as a fine and precise grain. It reveals notes of cherry, cherry blossoms, and more slightly - notes of violet associated with touches of blackberry, cuben pepper as well as discreet hints of nutmeg, sweet spices and an imperceptible hint of berries of laurel. The palate is mineral, nicely juicy, on the fruit, precise and offers a certain complexity, harmony as well as minerality. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/fresh cherry, juicy/fresh raspberry, and more slightly - notes of fresh violet associated with touches of

nutmeg, small red berries as well as discreet hints of fresh cornflower and fresh liquorice. The tannins are supple and chewy. Good length. Nice freshness/minerality. A very discreet hint of mocha on the finish. **Score: 16.25+ /20 - 93 /100**
