Domaine Julie Belland 2014 Comme Dessus (Santenay)

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POINTS

The wine comes from the highest point of the slope above Santenay, giving it an attractive cool and crisp character. With its delicious, refreshing acidity as well as ripe pear flavors it is balanced, minerally and with fine acidity. The aftertaste confirms that the wine is ready to drink.

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Domaine Julie Belland 2014 Morgeot Premier Cru (Chassagne-Montrachet)

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POINTS

Cellar Selection

Daughter of Roger Belland, Julie has taken over and changed the name of this estate. Based in Santenay, they also have vines in other appellations. This wine, for instance, is rich and structured with just the right amount of wood aging. It has vanilla, spice and great acidity from the citrus and apple fruits. The wine is still young and will be best from 2018.

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Domaine Roger Belland 2011 Santenay

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POINTS

Warm, ripe and rounded, this is a soft and attractive wine. It has touches of wood as well as some firm tannins that are embedded in the soft texture. It's a wine that will develop quickly and well. Drink from 2016.

WINE ENTHUSIAST

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Domaine Julie Belland 2014 Charmes (Santenay)

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POINTS

The wine is ripe, balanced and likely to be ready to drink soon. With its plump fruitiness and texture, it is a full wine. Rich red-berry fruits are gently balanced by acidity and supported with a light layer of tannins. It will be very drinkable from late 2017.
